

Requirements Procedure and Policy For Admitting An Organization As A Member of VMC

Preface

Section 1.2 (of Article 1) of the VMC By-Laws states:

"The purpose of the VMC is to provide a co-ordinating body for Vintage Motorsports."

Section 2.1 states:

"2.1. <u>Eligibility.</u> Membership in the VMC is open to responsible vintage motorsports groups in North America. Membership shall be by invitation and approval by an eighty percent majority favorable vote of the directors at a duly called and held meeting of the Board of Directors."

Requirements, Procedure and Policy

With those By-Law provisions in mind, VMC has adopted the following requirements, procedures and policies for membership in VMC:

To be considered for an invitation for membership, an organization must meet the following requirements and follow the following procedures:

- 1. An organization which desires to be considered for membership should have a representative attend at least one meeting of VMC as a guest prior to requesting membership.
- 2. Have a bonafide business structure (corporation, LLC, etc.) devoted primarily to vintage motorsports.
- 3. Have a written set of rules indicating a "vintage" and/or "historic" purpose and format.
- 4. Have a calendar of motorsport events.
- 5. Have completed at least one successful vintage motorsport event.
- 6. Provide the President of VMC documentation of the above requirements and request that membership be considered at an upcoming meeting. A representative of the organization will attend that meeting.

Consideration will be given at a regular bi-annual VMC meeting. If approved by 80% of the attending delegates the organization will be invited to become a regular member and upon payment of the first year annual dues, currently \$200, will be accepted as a regular member.
